However, many emergencies may prevent proper diagnosis and treatment due to their urgent nature. Thus, it's essential to understand the types of emergency situations that may arise during dental treatment and how to manage them effectively.

In this lecture, we will explore the types of patients presenting at the emergency room of a university hospital for dental-related issues and discuss their management.

Additionally, we will address other potential emergency scenarios in dental treatment and provide essential information for ensuring safe dental care.
